SECTION 2: Details of the Project

2.1 Please give a brief demographic and socio-economic background of the surrounding area (city, towns & villages) and the size of the population:

The final results of Burkina Faso's 5th RGP, conducted in 2019, give a total population of 20,505,155. This is the legal or resident population, comprising residents present (RP) and residents absent (RA) of ordinary households, collective households, and embassies. The resident population is composed of 10,604,308 women, or 51.7%, and 9,900,847 men, or 48.3%.

Burkina Faso's population is steadily increasing relative to the population size. From 5,638,203 inhabitants in 1975, it rose to 7,964,705 in 1985 and then to 10,312,609 inhabitants in 1996. Then, the Burkinabe population rose to 14,017,262 inhabitants in 2006 and then to 20,505,155 inhabitants in 2019. Thus, the country's population almost doubled between 1975 and 1996, and between 1996 and 2019. In other words, the population of Burkina Faso quadrupled from 1975 to 2019.

Demographic Structure: Population density varies greatly between regions. The Centre region stands out with a density of 1,014 inhabitants per km². The Plateau Central (114 inhabitants/km²), Centre-East (109 inhabitants/km²) and North (104 inhabitants/km²) regions also each have a density of more than 100 inhabitants per km². The five least densely populated regions are, in ascending order, the Sahel (31 inhabitants/km²), the East (41 inhabitants/km²), the Cascades (44 inhabitants/km²), the Southwest (53 inhabitants/km²) and the Boucle du Mouhoun (55 inhabitants/km²).

The central-western region hosts 20,973 internally displaced persons, according to official figures from 2021, from the permanent secretariat of the national emergency relief and rehabilitation council.

National Revenue: Burkina Faso is a landlocked country in the Sahel, with a low income and limited natural resources. With a 2020 GDP of USD 16.1 billion, for an estimated population of 20.9 million inhabitants growing at a rate of 2.9% per year (7% in the capital Ouagadougou), Burkina Faso falls into the category of least developed countries (LDCs) with a GDP per capita of around USD 768.8 (compared to USD 1,566.3 in sub-Saharan Africa).

Ratio of Population Living Below the Poverty Line: Burkina Faso is a low-income Sahelian country with limited natural resources. Its economy is based on agriculture and mining, particularly gold. More than 40% of its population lives below the national poverty line.

2.2 Details of the project:

In Ramadan 2025, your generosity reached far and wide poor Muslims in Burkina Faso. Ramadan which is the ninth month of the Islamic lunar calendar, marking the period when the Quran, the holy book of Islam, was revealed to our beloved prophet Muhammad. During this month, able-bodied Muslims abstain from food, drink, and other physical needs from dawn until sunset. This act of fasting is one of the five pillars of Islam, fundamental practices that define a Muslim's faith and practices. Ramadan, observed by nearly 1.8 billion Muslims worldwide, is a sacred month in the Islamic calendar dedicated to fasting, prayer, and reflection. It's a time when believers draw closer to God, practice self-discipline, and engage in acts of charity. Since 2015, our country (Burkina Faso) is experiencing an unprecedented

humanitarian crisis imposed by the terrorist armed groups which has provoked nearly 2 million of internally displaced people (IDP). And this food aid during the period of Ramadan will undoubtedly help the able bodied Muslim on the refugees' camps that we commonly called internally displaced and other needy people (IDP) who can hardly feed themselves properly to fast and to break easily. This food aid will exactly consist to distribute some food packages composed of 15kg of rice, 3 kg of sugar, 1,8 Lt of oil, 4,540 kg of Macaroni and 500g of date (fruit) for the 500 Burkinabe Muslims 'families. The distribution will take place in public spaces such as schools, mosques or any other large places that can accommodate a large number of people.

2.3 Why do you need this project?

The Muslim community in Burkina Faso represents nearly 63% of the population. This community is largely devout, but the vast majority live in poverty.

This situation is compounded by a dire security situation that has led to the forcible displacement of several thousand people from their homes. Many of these internally displaced persons come from predominantly Muslim regions and require support in several areas: food, shelter, social assistance, and healthcare.

The implementation of this project will help them to have adequate food for a certain period, depending on the size of each beneficiary's household.

The security crisis in Burkina Faso, the irregularity of rainfall during the seasons and the inflation of the prices of basic necessities, all these elements combined mean that the middle and lower classes have difficulty in feeding themselves properly, and this project aims to help poor families to be able to fast in the best possible conditions.

Indeed, people are no longer able to cultivate properly during the rainy seasons due to the deleterious security situation, while there is pressure on food sources due to the migratory flow to secure areas. Added to this is the very high inflation rate on the prices of consumer goods (the highest rate is 6.3% in October 2024, and the lowest is 2.4% in June 2024). source: national statistical institutes, BCEAO. In a world where poverty affects millions, international aid and development agencies are crucial in providing immediate relief and working towards sustainable solutions. With Yetim Vakfi foundation, we recognize the importance of supporting the most vulnerable communities and addressing the pressing issue of global hunger.

The products are purchased in large quantities, stored in the warehouses of the OSEH organization and then packaged in accordance with the quantities prescribed in the project to be transferred to the distribution site and finally handed over to the beneficiaries.

Hot meals are cooked in the afternoon; they will be ready before the break time and must be distributed to the orphans living in the different orphanges.

The OSEH organization has more than 10 years of experience in this type of project with the Wefa humanitarian relief foundation, and with other structures, thus contributing to reaching thousands of people across Burkina Faso. To date, the OSEH organization, through its partners, has distributed: 47394 food parcels, and handed out: 167211 hot meal kits.
