Total Population:

The final results of Burkina Faso's 5th RGPH, conducted in 2019, give a total population of 20,505,155. This is the legal or resident population, comprising residents present (RP) and residents absent (RA) of ordinary households, collective households, and embassies. The resident population is composed of 10,604,308 women, or 51.7%, and 9,900,847 men, or 48.3%.

Burkina Faso's population is steadily increasing relative to the population size. From 5,638,203 inhabitants in 1975, it rose to 7,964,705 in 1985 and then to 10,312,609 inhabitants in 1996. Then, the Burkinabe population rose to 14,017,262 inhabitants in 2006 and then to 20,505,155 inhabitants in 2019. Thus, the country's population almost doubled between 1975 and 1996, and between 1996 and 2019. In other words, the population of Burkina Faso quadrupled from 1975 to 2019.

Demographic Structure:

Population density varies greatly between regions. The Centre region stands out with a density of 1,014 inhabitants per km². The Plateau Central (114 inhabitants/km²), Centre-East (109 inhabitants/km²) and North (104 inhabitants/km²) regions also each have a density of more than 100 inhabitants per km². The five

<p>least densely populated regions are, in ascending order, the Sahel (31 inhabitants/km²), the East (41 inhabitants/km²), the Cascades (44 inhabitants/km²), the Southwest (53 inhabitants/km²) and the Boucle du Mouhoun (55 inhabitants/km²).</p>	
<p>Number of Refugees and Immigrants (if any): The central-western region hosts 20,973 internally displaced persons, according to official figures from 2021, from the permanent secretariat of the national emergency relief and rehabilitation council.</p>	
<p>National Income: Burkina Faso is a landlocked country in the Sahel, with a low income and limited natural resources. With a 2020 GDP of USD 16.1 billion, for an estimated population of 20.9 million inhabitants growing at a rate of 2.9% per year (7% in the capital Ouagadougou), Burkina Faso falls into the category of least developed countries (LDCs) with a GDP per capita of around USD 768.8 (compared to USD 1,566.3 in sub-Saharan Africa).</p>	<p>Population Rate Living Below the Poverty Line: Burkina Faso is a low-income Sahelian country with limited natural resources. Its economy is based on agriculture and mining, particularly gold. More than 40% of its population lives below the national poverty line.</p>
<p>Literacy Rate: The literacy rate of the population aged 15 or over is 61.2% in the commune of Ouagadougou. This rate is higher among men (66.5%) than among women (56.1%). Only 6.2% of this population is literate in one of the national languages compared to 60.7% for foreign languages. Overall, the education rate is 70.2%.</p>

<p>Short Description of Project:</p>	<p>This project is a social and humanitarian initiative aimed at supporting vulnerable households during the three days of the Eid al-Adha festival. It involves purchasing 200 cows in bulk, slaughtering them butchering them, and distributing the meat to the households heads struggling financially to provide for their families. Each household head will receive approximately 4-5 kg of meat, resulting in 120 beneficiaries per cow, and 24,000 beneficiaries per 200</p>
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	cows if we consider "6" as average number of a Burkinabe family.
Project Cause:	Eid al-Adha is a major event in the Muslim faith, commemorating Abraham's act of sacrificing his only son, Ismail, to fulfill his vow. However, a portion of the Muslim community worldwide lacks the financial means to do so. The project was designed to provide assistance to these vulnerable individuals in Burkina Faso, with nearly 4,000 households expected to benefit.
Project Goals:	The main objective is to bring smiles and joy to the vulnerable households in order to the spirit of the celebration, sharing, solidarity and love of neighbor is strengthened and maintained in the habits of societies towards one to another.
Target Audience:	Muslim community of Burkina Faso.
Beneficiary of Project:	4,000 heads of household directly, and 24,000 people indirectly.

Problems that may arise at the end of the project and measures/actions that can be taken: (If any)	Livestock prices are very high in Burkina Faso, and often there are no animals available in the markets, with many local livestock markets closed. OSEH will begin immediately by scouring the markets and increasing contacts with major suppliers to ensure that high quality cattle are found.


